Together we can build a future without hunger

Here at Chichester District Foodbank, we work alongside our community to ensure no one has to face hunger alone. Together, we support individuals and families across Chichester, Midhurst, Petworth, Selsey and surrounding villages who are struggling to afford life's essentials.

Every day, people are forced to make impossible choices — paying the rent or buying food, heating their homes or getting to work. The rising cost of living is now the biggest reason people turn to us for help. Around 50% of those we support simply don't have enough income to cover priority bills like rent, energy and council tax. Once those are paid, there is often nothing left for the essentials — and we believe everyone has a right to them.

By working together, we can make sure help is there when it's needed most. Last year, we provided around 6,000 emergency food parcels, with 38% going to children. But food is only the beginning.

Creating lasting change together

Our 'Beyond Food: Stronger Futures' ethos goes beyond providing emergency food parcels. It's also about tackling the root causes of hardship. Everyone who comes to us for food is offered additional support through our friendly signposting team. We work closely with local councils, charities and support groups who can help with everything from managing debt and housing issues to caring responsibilities, mental and physical wellbeing and many other challenges people face.

We also run free workshops and groups, helping people build confidence, skills and a sense of community. Our aim is to support people through crisis today while working towards a future where food banks are no longer needed.

The food bank brings people together. Through the groups, friendships form, confidence grows, and people are supported to move forward — not just get by.

I was nervous the first time I went to collect, but I was made to feel welcome, accepted and treated kindly and warmly by the whole team.

My husband had a stable job and was made redundant. When we didn't have the cash available to purchase food we'd turn to the food bank for support - being part of a community was fantastic.

I am a solo parent to four children, and to know that my cupboards are stocked, ready for their hungry tummies over the holidays is such a relief.

I am a single man fallen on hard times but not ever had much support or a positive foundation. I had nothing left and used this food bank, which helped me to foster hope in myself.

After turning my life around, I wanted to give back to those who helped me and decided to become a volunteer for the service. I get to hear people's stories and support them using my own experiences. I feel so lucky and fulfilled to be able to help in any way I can.”
